This wine is a Super-Tuscan, that is, a Sangiovese blend. We first produced it in 1995, to honor our mother's father, Bambino DiOrio. From the Abruzzo region of Italy, he was a fun-loving fellow. We made this wine to drink with almost any friend or any food. But, it can be taken seriously if that is your desire. This is done mostly to astound wine snobs. We take making our wine seriously, but remember Bambino as the original party animal. Aged 3 1/2 years before bottling, it is ready now, or will age another 5 to 8 years.
